HERE'S THE BASICS

Every day, you need to show up in the infopoint to check in. Here you'll get your food and drink-tickets along with a coloured wristband that gives you access to the backstage area where you can eat dinner and get coffee + snacks during the day. One shift will give you a food ticket (for dinner) and 3 drink tickets.

- ★ Dinner is served every day from 6 pm until 9 pm in the café next to the kitchen. The food ticket can NOT be used in the outside food-stall.
- ★ Your drinktickets can only be used in the regular bar in Dödsmaskinen. You can choose between regular beer and soft drinks.
- ★ Remember to show up on your assigned work-area **AT LEAST 15 MINUTES** before your shift starts. This is important.
- ★ Unfortunately, we cannot accomodate any volunteers. Ask us in the info point if you want tips for places to sleep (hostels, the campsite etc.)

BAR-VOLUNTEERS

You are either in the bar by the main stage (Salen) or Dödsmaskinen. In the bar, a person from the house, will show you how things work. This is also the person you go to if you have problems of any kind during your shift. If that person doesn't find you, please ask around.

KITCHEN-VOLUNTEERS

- ★ **1. BAND/VOLUNTEER FOOD.** This shift is in the upstairs kitchen. You will be preparing the food for bands and volunteers. There is a menu planned and groceries have been bought.
- ★ **2. SNACKBAR COOKING.** You are either in the upstairs kitchen or in the food-stall in the courtyard, preparing and making food for selling. Requires cooking skills.
- ★ **3. SNACKBAR / SELLING.** You are in the food-stall in the courtyard, selling burgers, fries etc. for guests. Requires minimal cooking skills.

Ask for the responsible person. She/he will show you how things work. This is also the person you go to if you have problems of any kind during your shift.

REMEMBER to wash your hands and keep the work area clean at all times. You have to wear an apron + gloves when in the food stall. **NO SMOKING** in the kitchen or the food stall, please.

CAFÉ VOLUNTEERS

You'll be taking care of the backstage area/café. Your task is to make tea, coffee, sandwiches, prepare snacks, clean toilets and so on. Go to the kitchen in the backstage area and ask for the person in charge. There is a detailed plan with your jobs.

DOOR-VOLUNTEERS

You will welcome guests, and point volunteers to the infopoint. Show up at the door and ask for the door-checker. You have to be sober on your shift!

CLEANING-CREW

You will be cleaning the festival area, venues and surrounding streets + the square. There is a detailed plan for you, with descriptions. Go and get it at the info-point!
